- 1) Fires shall be:
 - a. **Only be allowed within 20 yards east or west of a Caswell Beach public access.**
 - b. Fueled by firewood, vegetation or synthetic fire logs. No other material, including lumber or treated wood, shall be allowed.
 - c. Located 5 feet landward of the most recent two hightides and 50 feet from the closest dune/vegetation line.
 - d. Burned in a non-combustible container or excavated pit of a dimension no larger than four feet long and four feet wide.
 - e. Fueled to a maximum of height of two feet but never higher than the height of the container or pit.
 - f. Located landward of the high tide line as established by the most recent high tide, and a minimum of 50 feet from any vegetation and a minimum of 100 feet from any structures or established turtle nests.

- 2) Permit shall:
 - a. Only be issued to Caswell Beach property owners. A Property Owner is defined as the deedholder of the residence or its adult children at the age of 21 or older.
 - b. Assign responsibility for all damage to personal property of residents and the Town resulting from its beach fire to the property owner.
 - c. Require a property owner must always be in attendance during the fire. Property Owner must remain at the site of the fire until it is completely extinguished.
 - d. Conspicuously post permit within reasonable proximity (50 feet) from the fire.
 - e. Have sufficient equipment on site to extinguish the fire. Equipment should include, but not limited to, an operable fire extinguisher, 5-gallon bucket of water and a shovel.
 - f. Require the property owner to be responsible for removing all debris prior to leaving the site and return not later than 10:00 am the following morning to verify that all remnants of debris have been properly disposed. (DO NOT PUT MATERIALS IN TRASH CANS).
 - g. Not bury debris on the beach
